Detailed Itinerary

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 2: MARIGOT, ST MARTIN, FWI (IN PORT / 6:00PM)

Arrive Marigot. Embark SeaDream I from 2:00pm. All aboard 4:30pm.

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 3: CHARLESTOWN, NEVIS (8:00AM / 6:00PM)

Nevis is only 7 miles long and 5 miles wide, with natural vegetation that is unparalleled. From the top of the 3,232-foot Nevis Peak to the depths of the clear waters offshore, there is a world of flora and fauna to be explored.

Nevis is also the spot to explore the other half of your Caribbean getaway, under water. This place is perfect for the first time or casual scuba diver. Ample instruction is provided but no license is required. You'll be under the close and constant supervision of an expert dive master who will guide you to amazing shallow water sites like 'Hot Springs', 'Bug's Hole' and 'The Church Reef'. It's bucket list. Check.

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 4: SOUTH FRIARS BAY, ST KITTS (6:30AM / 2:00PM)

Intoxicating natural beauty, sunny skies, warm waters, and white sandy beaches combine to make **St. Kitts** one of the most seductive spots in the Caribbean. Christopher Columbus first spotted St. Kitts in 1493, when it was populated with native tribes, but the Europeans didn't colonize until the British arrived in 1623. Its strategic location and valuable sugar trade led to an advanced and luxurious development that was among the best in the Colonial Caribbean

Reopened in 2004, the course is played over 125 irrigated acres of lush grass and allows golfers to play along both the Caribbean Sea and on the Atlantic Ocean. TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 5: ST BARTS, FWI (IN PORT / 10:00PM)

First let's sort out this charming little island';s name. It's officially St. Barthelemy, as tagged by 17th century French settlers, plus there are nicknames including St. Barth's and St. Barts. We're going with **St. Barts** and it has a silent 's' at the end.

Now you're ready for the only overnight on our schedule. Large cruise ships are not permitted by law to dock which means you'll find all the duty free shopping you can imagine without the lines. There are no high rise buildings either, two-stories is the refreshing limit. There are also no timeshare salesmen, no beach vendors and nary a traffic light on this eight square mile speck of paradise.

What you will find is true tranquility, glitterati style. A blurb from the island's newspaper sums up the scene; "Russian billionaire Roman Abramovich is flying the Black Eyed Peas in to perform at a New Year's Eve party at his estate on St. Barts."

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 6: SANDY GROUND, ANGUILLA, (7:00AM / 10:00PM)

Anguilla is a British overseas territory. It is one of the most northerly of the Leeward Islands in the Lesser Antilles, lying east of Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands and directly north of Saint Martin.

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 7: SOPERS HOLE TORTOLA & NORMAN ISLAND (8:00AM / NOON & 1:00PM / 6:00PM)



Soper's Hole marina on **Tortola's** West End retains its quaint charm while being a center of activity and voted the best marina in the BVIs. SeaDream offers several land adventures including, snorkelling, scuba diving, land rover safari and swimming with the dolphins. The small boutiques of the marine also offer plenty shopping.

Over lunch *SeaDream I* makes the short sail to **Norman Island.** This privately owned island is uninhabited and could very well be the island reputed to be the inspiration for Robert Louis Stevenson's pirate novel Treasure Island. Guests may enjoy some great hiking opportunities as well as snorkelling and scuba diving.

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 8: WHITE BAY, JOST VAN DYKE, BVI (8:00AM / 6:00PM)

Named for an early Dutch settler and former pirate, rugged scenery and colorful folklore make up **Jost Van Dyke**. With fewer than 300 inhabitants, it measures just four miles by three with hiking trails that crisscross the island. Snorkelling and scuba enthusiasts will find Treasure Island and Sandy Spit National Park to be among the most best of the cruise. Club Paradise is famous for its conch stew while the Caribbean's most famous cocktail, "The Painkiller," was invented at The Soggy Dollar Bar. Notable inhabitants have included William Thornton, architect of the U.S. Capitol Building, and John Lettsome, founder of the London Medical Society.
